## Board of Education Meeting Thursday, January 4, 2018

Mr. Nolan led the Board and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following Board Officers were elected for 2018: Mike Keller was elected to serve as Board President; Mike Nolan was elected to serve as Board Vice President and Peggy Bush was elected to serve as Board Secretary. Mark Rajter was appointed as Treasurer and Mary Moss was appointed as Recording Secretary.

The Board President was given authorization to appoint members and chairpersons to the following committees for 2018: Finance and Operation; Student Advocacy and Communication; Teaching, Learning, and Technology; and Personnel. The Board President will also be authorized to appoint members and chairpersons to the Legislative Ad Hoc Committee.

Lapeer High School Principal, Doug Lindsay introduced new counselor, Liz Makedonsky, to the Lapeer High School team.

In addition, Mr. Lindsay along with counselor, Jan Ciaramella and teacher, Shannon Francis presented information on how Lapeer High School is working to reach the District Goal #1: Benchmark 1.2 A-C. "Ensure that every student has the opportunity to take meaningful steps toward their postsecondary career while in high school".

Mr. Lindsay reported Lapeer High School's 2017-2018 College & Coursework Data:

- Dual Enrollment – 325 Students
- Lapeer Early College – 90 Students
- Advanced Placement – 445 Students
- Ed Tech – 211 Students
- Total (Without duplicates) – 801 Students

Lapeer High School discussed how they have held multiple college preparedness presentations including, Paying for College/Know How to Go, FAFSA Completion Night, Early College Presentation and Opportunity Night.

Lastly, Lapeer High School, in partnership with Baker College, has developed a Running Start Program piloted by teacher, Shannon Francis in which students can earn a college credit.

The Board approved the minutes from the December 14, 2017 Regular Meeting.

Board Members thanked Mr. Lindsay and his staff for the presentation. They are pleased to see what is taking place at Lapeer High School.

Superintendent Wandrie thanked Mr. Lindsay and his staff for their presentation. He also discussed the guidelines for school closings and encouraged others to read the LCS Blog about Cancellation Guidelines due to weather.
