

Minutes of the Meeting of the Lapeer Community Schools Board of Education held on Thursday, March 24, 2016 at the Administration and Services Center

Mike Keller, President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Personnel Committee – Mike Nolan reported on the March 23 meeting when the following items were discussed: Negotiations, Superintendent Evaluation, Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent Contracts.

DISCUSSION TOPIC

M-STEP Update – Michelle Bradford began by explaining that late this afternoon, the House Budget subcommittee amended the MDE budget to discontinue M-STEP and redirected those funds to purchase a yet-to-be determined computer adaptive interim solution for the State assessment. The bill also eliminated funding for SAT testing.

With that being said, Mrs. Bradford reviewed the testing schedule the District will follow for M-STEP this spring. She also reviewed the fall PSAT results with the Board.
