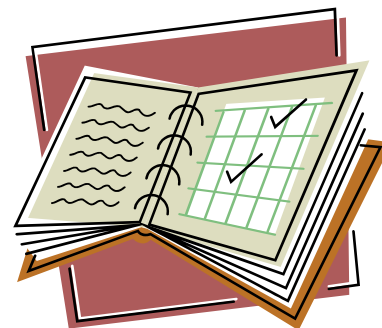

Year-Round Program

On Tuesday, July 29th over 150 students began their school year in our Year-Round middle school program. Students will be attending 2 hours of enrichment and take their 4 core classes for the rest of the day. Year-Round students will have several week-long breaks throughout the school year.

Earn money for RWMS by shopping at Meijer!

Rolland-Warner Middle School can earn money by doing something we normally do anyway—shop! If you are not already signed up, you can easily do so online. The website is Meijer.com/rewards and our school code is 779697. You can apply for a Meijer credit card or guest card, which will keep track of your purchase totals. We receive 1% on purchases made with Meijer credit card and 0.5% on purchases made with debit cards with pin numbers or cash.

Office Depot Rewards

When you shop at Office Depot, money goes to Rolland-Warner. At the checkout, the cashier will ask you if you'd like to identify a school to give rewards points to. Just tell them "Rolland-Warner" and that'll earn our school points. Once or twice a year, Office Depot sends a gift card to the principal that can be used to purchase items at the store. We use these for things such as note cards to send to parents, rewards for student positive behavior, gifts for student drawings, etc.

Student Citizenship Grade

Again this school year, students will be seeing a *Citizenship Grade* in addition to their academic grade on the report card at the end of each semester. This will allow parents to have a greater understanding of their child's success in the affective realm in skills such as timeliness, participation, effort, etc. The academic grade will be more focused on proficiency in the subject area. Student athletes will be expected to report their *Citizenship Grades* three times during each season to the Athletic Director and this info will be communicated to coaches.



Back to School Shopping

When you are out shopping for back to school clothes this

summer remember to check the school dress code policy. Staff members of Lapeer Community Schools strive to be aware of contemporary dress and grooming styles, but ask both students and parents to keep in mind that school is operated for the educational growth of youth in an atmosphere of dignity and seriousness of purpose.

Students are expected to dress in a neat, clean, and modest manner that does not detract from the educational purposes of the school. Hats are not to be worn in the building.

To maintain this standard, students are not to wear the following types of apparel:

- 1) Spandex clothing and leotards
- 2) Tube tops
- 3) Halters
- 4) Items which bare the child's back to the waistline or bare the midriff
- 5) Mesh tops
- 6) Tops that have plunging necklines and/or arm holes
- 7) Clothing with obscene, offensive, or inappropriate statements and/or graphic designs
- 8) Biking shorts
- 9) Slashed or torn clothing

FALL ATHLETIC CLEARANCE PROCESS:

- All athletes must meet with the athletic director
- All athletes must have a completed physical (dated April 15, 2013 or after)
- All athletes must have a completed emergency card
- All athletes must have a signed Athletic Code of Conduct card (parent & student signatures required)
- All 8th grade athletes must have an eligibility check (Student must have passed 67% of 2nd semester 7th grade classes. Summer school classes will be considered for eligibility.)

FALL ATHLETIC CLEARANCE DATES AND TIMES:

School administration will be holding athletic clearance **at the Zemmer Campus** for all 7th grade athletes during the week of August 11th-14th. Monday and Tuesday from 8:30am-2:30pm and Wednesday and Thursday from 12noon-6pm.

At this time, student athletes can turn in their physical, student code of conduct and permission to treat cards. Students will also be academically cleared to participate in athletics.

Please call for a specific appointment or drop-in during one of these scheduled times.
