## Social Media Presentation

As part of our Positive Behavior Intervention & Supports system at Rolland-Warner, and in conjunction with State Trooper, Steve Kramer and the Child Advocacy Center of Lapeer County, we will be hosting a session on the dangers and legal ramifications of inappropriate use of electronic media such as texting, Facebook, and other social media. Students will hear a presentation that includes legal information about sending inappropriate photos and messages and making threats. The presenters will also address some of the short term and long term consequences that are possible with these actions. Students will also be provided with some strategies to remove themselves from these situations as well. The session will be approximately an hour in length and your child will attend either on Monday, December 8<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, December 9<sup>th</sup> depending on his/her schedule.
